

The Prouty Century Ride - July 15,2023 HELP NEEDED

Hi folks,

Due to an unfortunate decision by event management, the Prouty was moved (this year only) to the weekend following the usual date. As a result, we now have significant conflicts with other events, family plans, etc. and have only half the operators we need to run this very large event safely. It covers over 100 miles of roads. It starts and ends at the Richmond Middle School in Hanover, with multiple routes going up the NH side of the Connecticut River and returning down the Vermont side. There's also a loop through the mountains out Rt. 25A to Rt. 25.

The Prouty is Saturday, July 15th, and runs from early morning until almost 5 PM. All operations are on 2m on linked repeaters (mobiles needed), and if you have APRS that's a bonus for rovers. We have open positions for fixed SAG sites and mobile "rovers" right now. Rover vehicles should be able to carry a bike and rider for a short distance if needed.
